The tour is one of seven being held throughout the fall in cities around Texas. Each event will be regionally tailored, bringing together partners, speakers and legislators to discuss, analyze and raise public awareness on key regional and statewide mental health issues.

“With the upcoming 2015 legislative session, we have a unique opportunity to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of how mental health care is delivered to Texans,” said Tom Luce, chief executive officer of The Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute. “In order to impact change, input from those at the local level is critical. We hope that this tour will spark

thoughtful conversations about mental health issues and help us identify and implement promising best practices and policies.”

These seven events follow the successful launch of the Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute in April 2014. The Meadows Foundation established the institute to work with partners across the state to identify best practices, explore innovative new approaches, and find policies that work to deliver efficient and effective mental health care to Texans.
